The field trip is based in Palermo Sicily, the capital city of *Cosa Nostra* Sicilian Mafia. Professor Gabriele Simoncini, who lived in the area, accompanies students throughout, lecturing on the historical, political and sociological aspects of the local culture and the politics of crime. Students will be guided through the region, seeing for themselves the places that witnessed the worst mafia crimes in recent history, and honoring the victims.
